

Austin Davies

Austin has a love of colour and texture unmatched by many of his contemporary artists. His treatment of depth-of-field is only surpassed by his exploration of emotion and the unconscious. Austin's past association with the theatre and dance has given him an insight into lighting and theatrical movement only akin to Degas before him.

Austin Davies migrated to New Zealand from England some 25 years ago. He qualified in painting at Liverpool University School of Arts. He has works in civic collections in Liverpool, Manchester, Leeds, Salford and Hertford College Oxford; and in private collections in England, Switzerland, Austria, the USA, Canada, Hong Kong, Australia and New Zealand.

In New Zealand Austin exhibits with Oedipus Rex in Auckland, Ferner in Wellington, Dobson Bashford in Christchurch and Taylor-Jensen in Palmerston North.

In London he exhibits with Coombs Contemporary Gallery.

In Canberra, Australia, he exhibits through KIKU ARTs.
